An **employer-driven** education and training solution that provides structured **on-the-job training (OJT)** and instruction to apprentices for specific occupations which culminates in a nationally recognized (portable) completion certificate issued by the Florida Department of Education.

## **Purpose of Apprenticeship**

Registered Apprenticeship is an **employer-driven** process that enables **employers** to develop and apply industry recognized standards to training programs with the intention of:

- ☐ increasing productivity;
- ☐ improving quality of the workforce;
- ☐ retaining company knowledge; and
- ☐ reducing turnover.

It affords **apprentices** the opportunity to fast track their career goals, avoid debt, earn competitive wages and access a career pathway.

Apprentices receive onthe-job training from an experienced mentor for typically not less than a year.

Apprenticeships combine on-the-job learning with technical education at community colleges, technical schools, apprenticeship training schools, provided online or at the jobsite.

Apprentices receive increases in wages as they gain higher level skills.
